

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT  
FOR THE PROVISION OF FIREFIGHTING AND RESCUE SERVICES AT  
CENTENNIAL AIRPORT**

This Second Amendment to the Agreement is for the purchase of two ARFF Apparatus (this “Amendment”) is entered by and between the SOUTH METRO FIRE RESCUE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (“South Metro”) and the ARAPAHOE COUNTY PUBLIC AIRPORT AUTHORITY (the “Authority”)

**RECITALS**

- A. South Metro and the Authority entered into an Agreement for the provision of firefighting and rescue services to Centennial Airport as of January 27<sup>th</sup>, 1982; and
- B. The Parties desire to amend the Agreement, as further described herein.

**AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS South Metro provides Aircraft Rescue Firefighting (“ARFF”) to Centennial Airport from Station 35, located at 12080 E. Briarwood Ave. Englewood, CO 80112, and Station 44, located at 12625 E. Lincoln Ave. Parker, CO 80134; and

WHEREAS South Metro utilizes a Fleet Capitol Forecast to determine life cycle and serviceability of fire apparatus which states that specialty apparatus serve twenty (20) years in front-line status; and

WHEREAS The two primary ARFF apparatus utilized for aircraft crash incidents (a 1999 E-One Titan II 4×4, and a 1988 (Refurbished in 2014) Oshkosh T-2500 6x6) are beyond the twenty-year life cycle; and

WHEREAS South Metro has conducted due diligence and research to determine the appropriate replacement apparatus; and

WHEREAS The Vendor Front Range Fire Apparatus (“Front Range”), representing Oshkosh Corporation (“Oshkosh”) has been selected to construct and provide replacement apparatus within three hundred and fifty (350) days from a completed purchase order; and

WHEREAS The purchase price for both shall not exceed two million dollars (\$2,000,000), including delivery and handling.

WHEREAS Both parties find that this amendment to the Agreement will benefit the Airport, County of Arapahoe, and the areas serviced by South Metro.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES HERIN, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. South Metro will enter into an agreement with Front Range to construct and deliver two (2) Oshkosh Stryker 4X4 ARFF Firefighting Apparatus to be delivered three hundred and fifty (350) days from completed purchase order.
2. South Metro and the Authority split the cost of both apparatus (50%-50%).
3. South Metro will monitor the apparatus construction and complete inspections as appropriate throughout the process.
4. South Metro assumes sole responsibility for housing, operating, equipping, insuring and routine maintenance for both apparatus.
5. South Metro and the Authority agree to split the cost of tire replacement as needed (every seven (7) years per NFPA standards).
6. Red-1 (1988/2014 Oshkosh) will be sold once the two new apparatus are in service. South Metro and the Authority will split the proceeds of that sale (50%-50%).
